




- The Committee shall contribute effectively to address the grievances at the earliest.

Subject: Issue of Renewal of Fire Safety Certificate for the Running Educational building in eight (8) several blocks (Group of Institutions) in favour of NSHM COLLEGE OF MANAGEMENT & TECHNOLOGY over L.R. Plot Nos.2717/3370, 2726/3361, under Mouza- Arrah, J.L. No. 91, P.S.- Kanksa, Dist.- Paschim Bardhaman.

This is in reference to your letter dated 01/11/2021, Vide Previous Memo No. FES/BDN/681/2017, dated. 06/04/2017.

The Performances of the Fire Fighting system as incorporated G+3 storied building were tested at random and found satisfactory working condition. In view of the above this office is hereby releasing the Renewal of Fire Safety Certificate for occupancy of the aforesaid building.

However to up-keep the Fire safety measure of the aforesaid building the following safety measures are to be incorporated.

Recommendation:

Construction:

1. The whole construction of the existing building shall be carried out as per approved plan drawings confirming the relevant building rules of local Municipal Body.
2. The Floor area exceeds 750 m² shall be suitably compartmented by separation walls up to ceiling level having at least two hours Fire resisting capacity.
3. The interior finish decoration of the building shall be made low flame spread materials conforming I.S. specifications.
4. Provision of ventilation at the Central core-duct of the building shall be provided.
5. Arrangements shall have to be made for sealing all the vertical ducts by the materials of adequate Fire Resisting capacity.
6. The Open space surrounding the building shall conform the relevant building rules as well as permit the accessibility and maneuverability of Fire appliance with turning facility.
7. The approach roads shall be sufficiently strong to withstand the load of Fire Engine weighting up to 20 M.T.
8. The width and height of the access gates into the premises shall not be less than 4.5-5 M respecting abutting the road staircase.

STAIRCASE:

9. The stair cases of the building shall be enclosed R.C.C. type made of bricks having Fire Resisting capacity not less than 4 hrs. & two stair cases for each block shall be provided.
10. The stair cases of the building shall have permanent vents at the top and open able sashes at each floor level in the external wall of the building.
11. The width of the stair cases shall be made as marked in the plan. Corridors and the exit doors shall conforming the relevant building rules and well as rules of the cinematograph Act, With up-to-date amendments.
12. All the stair cases shall be extended up to terrace of the building and shall be negotiable to each other without entering into any room.
13. Fire and smoke check doors at the entrances of all stair case enclosures as marked in the plan at each floor level shall be provided. The F.C.D. shall be of at least one hour Fire resisting wire glass window fitted with self-closing type openable in the direction of escape

FIRE FIGHTING WATER:

14. Underground W/R having Water capacity 20,000 lts. and overhead reservoir of 10,000 lts exclusively for Fire Fighting purpose with replenishing arrangements @ 1000 lts/min. preferably from two different sources of water supply shall be provided.

HYDRANT SYSTEM:

15. Provision for hose reel in conjunction with Wet riser-cum- down comer of 100 mm dia having landing valve at each floor, connected to overhead reservoir through Booster Pump of 1200 LPM shall be made conforming the relevant I.S. specifications.
16. Yard hydrant/Ring main type at least three numbers hydrant shall be installed surrounding the building in accordance with relevant I.S. specification.
17. Proper Replenishing Arrangement shall have to be made to keep the O.H.W.R. full at all time.

ELECTRICAL INSTALLATION & DISTRIBUTION:

18. The electrical installation including transformers, switch gears, Main & Meters etc. and the distribution system of the premises shall be made satisfying the code of practice for Fire safety in general building as laid down in I.S. specification 1946-1982.
19. The Vertical ducts shall be supplied sealed at alternative floor level.
20. The electrical installation shall be adequately protected with CO2 /D.C.P. or Medium Velocity water projector system.
21. **Alternative power supply:** - Arrangements shall be made to supply with the help of generator to operate at least the Fire pump, pump for deep tube well , Fire Alarm system, Fire lift etc. and also illuminating the stair case, corridors, exit etc. of the building in case of normal power failure.



DETECTION ALARM SYSTEM:

22. Manually operated Electrical Fire Alarm system with at least three nos. of break glass type call boxes fitted with hooters along with P.A. system, tack back facilities at each floor connecting with audio- visual panel board shall be made in the control room. The control room shall be located at the entrance of the ground floor of the building, other requirements of the system shall be made conforming I.S. 2189-1988.
23. Hooter will be sounded in such a manner so that an operation of a Detector or Manual Call pont Hooters will sound on the same floor and immediate alternate floor.

AIR CONDITION SYSTEM: - (If any) :-

24. The A.H.U. shall be separated for each floor with the system of Air Ducts for individual floors.
25. Arrangement shall be made for isolation at the strategic Locations by incorporating Auto Dampers in the Air Condition System.
26. The system of auto shut down of A.H.U. shall be incorporated with the auto detection and alarm system.
27. The air handling unit's room shall not be used for storage of any combustible materials.

FIRST AID FIRE FIGHTING SYSTEM:-

28. First Aid Firefighting arrangement in the style of placing suitable type of portable Fire Extinguishers, Fire Buckets etc. in all floors and vulnerable locations of the premises shall be made in accordance with I.S. 2190-1992.

GENERAL RECOMMENDATIONS:

29. Fire notice for Fire Fighting installations and evacuation from the building shall be prepared and displayed at all vulnerable places of the building.
30. Floor nos. and directional sign of escape route shall be displayed prominently.
31. The employees and security staff shall be conversant with installed the Fire Fighting equipment of the building and to operate in the event of Fire and testing.
32. Arrangement shall be made for regular checking, testing and proper maintenance of all the Fire Safety installations and equipment installed in the building to keep them in perfectly good working condition at all times.
33. A crew of trained Fireman under experienced officer shall be engaged round the clock for safty of the building.
34. Mock Fire Drill and Evacuation drill shall be performed periodically with participation of all occupants of the building.
35. The Renewal of Fire Safety Certificate is valid for a period of Five years from the date of issue, and has to be renewed after five years certifying about the satisfactory services, performances of all the Life and Fire Safety arrangements installation of the building.




